48/15 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

TCP/32183: Honeysuckle Cottage, High Street, Godshill. Single storey extension on side elevation to form wc, utility lounge and replacement porch.

TCP/32194: Naragar, Newport Road, Godshill. Conversion of loft to provide storeroom. Additional window on north elevation.

TCPL/12291/N: Retention of extension on rear elevation providing additional seating capacity.

RESOLVED: To make no objection to the applications but to make comment regarding the inconsistency in the plans for TCP/32183 in respect of the window in the downstairs washroom.
