He also reported on a serious road traffic incident on Newport Road involving a Staples lorry and a lady with a push chair, resulting in whiplash and dragging of the pushchair.

Concern had again been expressed by a resident re the parking of cars and speed of traffic on Newport Road.

RESOLVED: The Clerk write to Island Roads expressing the above concerns and to Staples regarding the traffic incident, size of vehicles using the highway and site access.

Mrs Child would ask at the school re the placement of a noticeboard in the playground looking out onto the road. Repairs were required to the board at the Smithy and the noticeboard opposite the Model Village was seen as having unsatisfactory positioning.
