**A MEETING OF GODSHILL PARISH COUNCIL WAS HELD AT GODSHILL METHODIST HALL AT 7.30 PM ON MONDAY 2ND JULY 2018.**

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Councillors Bacon, Banks, Button, Child, Nigh, and Thrower.

**ALSO IN ATTENDANCE:** G Hughes (Clerk). IW Councillor Downer and three members of the public.

**7.30pm to 8.00pm time allocated for residents of Godshill Parish to speak to the Council on Parish Council matters.**

Jon Gilbey of Shanklin Town Council attended to give a presentation on the provision of new public conveniences, as had been recently undertaken at two sites in Shanklin. He advised that the new conveniences had involved considerable capital expenditure but had significantly reduced running costs in both utility bills and cleaning costs. There was also significant income from charges and this was anticipated to generate £35,000 in a full year. Mr Gilby agreed to supply further information in order that it could be considered at a future meeting of Godshill Parish Council.

## **128/18 TREEWORCS & KNOTWEED AT CENTRAL MEAD**

The Clerk reported that the knotweed had received a first course of treatment, that the fallen tree had been removed and that he would now arrange for the replacement of the two damaged fence panels.

## **129/18 TREE WORKS AT CHURCH HILL**

The Council had previously agreed to fund a half share of the cost of the removal of dead trees at the boundary of the Memorial Garden. A quotation had yet to be received from the owner of the adjacent property. The Clerk had contacted the owner and a quotation was expected in due course.

## **130/18 ISLE OF WIGHT DAY**

Councillor Bacon declared an interest as a member of the organising Committee. He advised on planned events for the day which included volunteer litter picks, a parade and competitions. It was agreed that community support for participation would be sought during the course of the Summer Fayre, as would the participation of children from the village. Councillor Nigh would be the Parish Councils Ambassador for the event..

## **131/18 ELECTORAL REVIEW OF ISLE OF WIGHT**

The Isle of Wight Council had published its comments for the review and there were no proposed changes affecting Godshill Parish Council.

## **132/18 SUMMER FAYRE**

Councillor Nigh gave a comprehensive update for the day and suggested that a letter be sent to the two properties adjacent to the entrance, advising them of the event. The Clerk advised that the Temporary Event Notice had been submitted and accepted by the Isle of Wight Council and that Hampshire Police had been advised accordingly. The Clerk would arrange for grasscutting to take place two or three days before the event.

**134/18 REPORT OF IW COUNCILLOR**

Councillor Downer had received a number of complaints regarding the quality of grasscutting along country lanes and he had contacted Island Roads regarding such. A motorcycle bay was to be provided in the car park and the resurfacing of Beacon Alley was to be undertaken this month. The IW Council had an officer who could be approached for any needed advice regarding hedgehogs.

Mr Farrow reported on his contact with representatives of Wroxall Parish Council regarding the printing of a new format Village News, on which he had been working. Due to holiday commitments at Wroxall progress had been slow and costs of engaging a private printer were prohibitive. Miss Nigh would enquire regarding an alternative printing source.
