108/18 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

112/18 TREE WORKS AND KNOTWEED AT CENTRAL MEAD.

The Clerk had met on site with Mr Brian Leach at the property adjoining the old telephone exchange. Mr Leach had previously been engaged on the successful treatment of knotweed on the boundary with The Smithy buildings.

The Clerk and Mr Leach had also visited a nearby property where a fallen tree had damaged fence panelling.

The Clerk had instructed Mr Leach to proceed with knotweed treatment and the removal of the fallen tree which had damaged the fencing.

RESOLVED: That the treatment of knotweed and treeworks be confirmed and that the damaged fence panels be replaced.

113/18 TREE WORKS AT CHURCH HILL

The Council had previously agreed to fund a half share of the cost of the removal of dead trees at the boundary of the Memorial Garden. A quotation had yet to be received from the owner of the adjacent property.

114/18 ISLE OF WIGHT DAY

Mrs Child reported on proposed possible actions by local councils across the island and the possible participation in a parade. Beach litter and other litter picking were projects that were being undertaken across the island. The Clerk would contact Robin Courage regarding an itinerary.

115/18 ELECTORAL REVIEW OF ISLE OF WIGHT

The Isle of Wight Council had published its comments for the review and there were no proposed changes affecting Godshill Parish Council.

116/18 PURCHASE OF PROJECTOR

The need for a projector was recognised having regard to the viewing of planning applications on an ongoing monthly basis. The Clerk had viewed possible purchases online and it was –

RESOLVED: To proceed with the purchase of a projector at an estimated cost of £200.

117/18 CORRESPONDENCE

A list of correspondence had been circulated. The Chairman read out a letter received from the Chairman of 1st Godshill & Rookley Scout Group in connection with the possible use of the Scout Hall for meetings, which stated that possible joint use was not seen as a realistic or feasible option.

118/18 REPORT OF IW COUNCILLOR

IW Councillor reported that the hedges at the car park were being cut, that surface water was still being addressed at Lessland Lane. Strong concern was still being expressed to him regarding parking at the school and highway safety, he advised that IW Council were going to increase the number of patrols at critical periods of the day.
